The Goal of the *Family-driven Care and Practice System Self-Assessment Tool* is to help family-run organizations, providers, agencies, and collaborative projects quickly get a sense of their current capacity to make the transformation to family-driven care and practice.



The *Family Driven Care and Practice System Self Assessment Tool* was designed to be used following a PowerPoint presentation introducing the definition of family-driven care and what it takes to make the paradigm shift to family-driven practice. This tool has three sections.

- The first **Readiness**, taps participant's perceptions.
- The second **Infrastructure**, describes the current environment.
- The third **Resources**, identifies tangible supports for making the transformation to family-driven care and practice.

This tool is intended to be used in an interactive way with a group of individuals from either similar or diverse perspectives or roles. It is not a paper and pencil test to be rated or scored. Its value comes from a facilitated discussion with the respondents. It is assumed that participants will be from the same community, same agency, or are coming together to collectively address a common concern or develop an initiative in which all of them have an interest.

- A complete PowerPoint presentation with detailed speaker notes;
- The *Family Drive Care and Practice System Self Assessment Tool* with detailed instructions and guidance for using it; and
- Handouts and background documents.
